**ORDER:**

3. Administrative sanction orders have been issued for construction of New (9) APSWR Schools complexes for Rs.13.00 Crores to each school vide G.O.Ms.No.93, Social Welfare (RS.2) Department, dt.17-12-2013 & G.O.Ms.No.10, Social Welfare (RS.2) Department, dt.25-01-2014.
